3) Academics & Co-Curricular

We run the NaCCA standards-based curriculum (KG, Primary, JHS), with emphasis on English, French, Arabic, STEM, Robotics, and Abacus.

Open for Creche/Nursery, KG, Lower/Upper Primary, JHS 1-3.

Entrance Assessment: JHS/Upper Primary — English, Maths, Science; Lower Primary/KG — Literacy & Numeracy.

Application Fee: GH¢50 (forms available online or at school). Submit with two passport photos, birth certificate, previous school report, and transfer letter (for transfers). Office hours: Mon–Fri, 8:00 a.m.–3:00 p.m.
